Unpaid School Meals

Following the October half term break there will changes to our school meal payment system. After two weeks, if dinner money is still outstanding then we will no longer be able to offer your child a school meal. You will be informed by a text on the Friday if this is the case. A packed lunch must then be provided from home until the debt is settled, only then your child can continue receiving school meals.

School Meals are £2.10 a day, £10.50 a week. Please make Cheques made payable to 'Cheshire East Council' (CEC). The money should arrive to school on Monday morning for that week in an envelope marked with the child's name and class on the front. We have a secure wooden box by the main playground entrance where you can drop off your envelopes. This is checked daily.

If for any reason you are experiencing problems paying for school meals then please come in and talk to the Head teacher. If you wish to check if you are eligible for free school meals please phone Cheshire East on the number below and they will let you know if the child in your care is entitled to Free School Meals.


Operation Christmas Child
